"Shall Thurston County School District 0016 (Umo Ho Nation Public Schools) in the State of Nebraska issue its bonds in a total principal amount not to exceed Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000) for the purposes of financing the costs of (i) constructing, equipping and furnishing a career academy addition to the District's existing high school building which will provide classrooms, laboratories and an auditorium, and (ii) constructing certain renovations of and improvements to the District's existing school building; said bonds to be issued from time to time, to be sold at such prices, to bear interest at such rates, to become due at such times, and to have such other terms and provisions, all as may be fixed and determined by the Board of Education of the District; and

"Shall the District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes, not to exceed five cents (\$.05) per one hundred dollars (\$100) of taxable valuation, against all the taxable property in the District sufficient in rate and amount to pay the principal of, the premium, if any, and the interest on said bonds as the same become due?"

"Shall the Rosalie Rural Fire District be allowed to levy a property tax not to exceed 6 cents (\$.06) per one hundred dollars of taxable valuation in the General Fund and a property tax not to exceed 4 cents (\$.04) per one hundred dollars of taxable valuation in the Ambulance Fund, which is in excess of the limits prescribed by law for the 2020-2021 fiscal year and until and including fiscal year 2024-2025 for the purpose of all the general operations of the Fire District?"

"Shall the Village of Rosalie be allowed to levy a property tax not to exceed \$1.05 per one hundred dollars of taxable valuation in excess of the limits prescribed by law for the 2021-2022 fiscal year and until and including fiscal year 2025-2026 for the purpose of both general operations and building construction, remodeling, or site acquisition?"

In compliance with Section 32-811(1) R.R.S. Nebraska 1998 "where the names of candidates properly filed for nomination do not exceed two candidates for each vacancy to be filled, these candidates shall be declared nominated and their names will not appear on the Primary Election Ballot".
