

Modified Business Practices for Thurston County Offices and Buildings

Beginning Monday, March 30, 2020, Thurston County Offices will be conducting business in a modified manner in order to comply with COVID-19 social distancing guidelines recommended by Federal and State agencies. All Thurston County offices will be open for business via phone call, email and regular mail. If a matter cannot be resolved remotely, please contact the office of your need so an appointment can be scheduled. Please call or email ahead of time for an appointment as the doors at County facilities will be locked and access will only be granted to those who have a scheduled appointment. We encourage all individuals who need services to access these online or over the phone when possible. Thurston County officials want to provide the safest possible environment for employees and the citizens who are inside our facilities conducting business. In accordance with the Governor's recommendations, no more than 10 individuals will be allowed to congregate in open areas throughout County offices and spaces.

DMV: The State of Nebraska has cancelled all Driver's License physical testing until further notice. Should you simply need a license renewal an appointment will be necessary; services may be limited. For an appointment, call the corresponding number below. DMV services in Thurston County are the second Thursday of each month.

COURTS: Anyone wishing to attend a court hearing will have to have approval from the Court in order to be granted access inside the Courthouse.

ELECTIONS: All Thurston County Registered Voters are encouraged to complete and return the application to vote by mail. In-person early voting starts Monday April 13, 2020. Unless the Governor changes State Statute for early voting for the PR20 election before then, access for early voting will need to be obtained by making an appointment. Please call the election office.

BOARD MEETINGS: Until further notice, regularly scheduled Thurston County Board of Supervisors meeting will go on as scheduled; however, we will apply the Governor's recommendations of no more than 10 individuals in the Boardroom during the meeting.

DROP BOX: the public will find a drop box located on the East side of the building by the handicap parking area.

Thurston County officials will monitor the ongoing COVID-19 Pandemic guidelines daily and make adjustments to our business practices and services to the public as needed. Thank you for your understanding and patience during these very challenging circumstances.
